

Mrs. Kaufman Services Held

Mrs. Margaret Christina
Kaufman, 68, of Rte. 1, Tama,
a well-known Haven Com-
munity resident, died Wed-
nesday at Grinnell General
Hospital of cancer.

The daughter of John and

Charles W. Kaufman of
