

Word has been received of the death, Wednesday, July 11th, of Ithamar Conkey Kellogg, of Hadley, Mass., a brother of R. M. Kellogg, and a resident of Grinnell from 1855 until 1861. His two sons were born in Grinnell, and at this place he enlisted in Co. E, 4th Iowa Cavalry. After his discharge from the army he returned with his family to Hadley, Mass., where he has since resided. He has been a highly respected citizen of Hadley, where he has held many offices of honor and trust, and has also been a consistent member of the First Congregational church of that place. The funeral services were held in Hadley at 2 p.m. Thursday, at the same hour at which services were held in Grinnell in memory of Mrs. J. K. James, the widow of an own cousin of Mr. Kellogg's. Mr. Kellogg was 73 years old.
