**Charles Wm. Kelly,
76, Passed Away
Thursday Evening**

Charles William Kelly of 808 Summer street, passed away Thursday evening in a Grinnell hospital at the age of 76 years.

Funeral services were held Saturday at 4 p. m. at the James Funeral Home, with burial in Hazelwood cemetery.

Charles William Kelley, son of Charles and Ellen Kelley, was born Dec. 6, 1872, and passed away at St. Francis Hospital August 18 as a result of a stroke and a heart ailment. Mr. Kelley had spent the past forty years in Grinnell, moving here from Blythe, Iowa. He was employed at the Spaulding Carriage works and later was employed by the public schools for twenty-three years.

He was a member of the Eagles lodge in Oskaloosa for a number of years and later became a member of the Grinnell lodge. He was also a member of the Odd Fellows.

He was united in marriage with Barbara L. Roe in 1902. His wife preceded him in death in April of 1944.

He leaves to mourn him two sisters, Mrs. Katie Beadle of Iowa City and Mrs. Mary Bryan of Des Moines, one brother John of Albia, and a step-son, George Roe of Grinnell.
