## Graveside Services Here Tuesday For Thomas W. Kelly

Graveside services for Thomas W. Kelly, 65, of Fort Wayne, Ind., will be held at 3 p.m. Tuesday at Hazelwood cemetery. Mr. Kelly died suddenly Thursday in Lafayette, Ind., where he had been temporarily residing.
