Conney M. Kimbo, University of Pittsburgh vice president for student affairs since 1979 and former dean of student affairs at Grinnell College, died of cancer April 13 at a Pittsburgh hospital.

A native of McKeesport, Pa., Dr. Kimbo served in the U.S. Army prior to earning his bachelor's degree in physical education and English at Indiana University in 1958. He received a master's degree in health education from the same institution in 1968 and earned a doctorate in educational administration from the University of Iowa.

Prior to joining the Grinnell faculty, he was a teacher and coach with the Gary, Ind., public schools. He was named assistant professor of physical education at Grinnell where he coached wrestling and football. He became dean of student affairs in 1970.

Dr. Kimbo served as dean of student affairs at the University of Missouri-St. Louis from 1973 to 1979. He had served in the same capacity at Pitt for 10 years.

Surviving are four children, Sandra, Conney Jr., Donna

and Karen; two sisters, Agnes Asbury and Sallie Johnson; and a granddaughter.
