Esther Elmira, daughter of Mary and Nathan Harrington, was born at Williamstown, Vermont, June 28, 1863, and departed this life November 5, 1914. When she was three years of age her parents moved to Western Iowa where they experienced the pleasures and aardships of the early frontier life.
