Alice E. Green was born in Waterford, Virginia. April 22, 1848; died at the city hospital in Grinnell. Iowa, April 10th, 1915, aged 66 years, 11 months and 19 days.

She came to low with her parents when a child, and was united in marriage to J. M. Kirk at Davenport, October 7th, 1868. To them were born five children, the boys who died in infancy, and two daughters. Mrs. Jeff Sheely who recently moved to Colorado and could not be present and Mrs. Gertrude Rempp, who has made her home with her the past few years and was with her to the last.

She leaves to mourn her departure besides her husband and children two brothers. John S. Green, of Wichita. Kansas, and J. R. Green, of Colorado, and three sisters. Mrs. Mary E. Thompson, of Tampa, Florida, Mrs. l. J. Wright of Normal, Illinois, and Mrs. Martha Trafton, of Crookton, Minn.

She came to Grinnell in 1882, went to Montezuma in 1888, and moved back to Grinnell in 1907, where she has resided ever-since. She was a member of the Christian church since a little girl, and held firmly to the faith to the end. She has been in very poor health for the past-five years and bore her suffering patiently till the messenger came and took her home.

Funeral services were held at the home Monday afternoon at 3 p. m., conducted by Rev. J. M. Brown, and on Tuesday morning she was taken to Davenport and laid to rest beside her three boys in the beautiful Oak Cemetery.
