

Kirkpatrick Dies in Omaha ^{8/18/74}

Stewart R. Kirkpatrick, a trustee of Grinnell since 1937, died Sunday, Aug. 18, in Omaha, at the age of 81.

A graduate of the college in the class of 1915, Kirkpatrick was retired board chairman of the investment firm of Kirkpatrick, Pettis, Smith, and Polian. The firm represents a number of investment banking houses, architects, engineers, and contractors.

A native of Waterloo, Kirkpatrick lived in Grinnell during his early years and graduated from Grinnell High School in 1911.

As a member of the Grinnell College board, he served on the finance committee from 1937 to 1943. He was named vice-president of the board in 1939 and from 1944 to 1948 was president of the board.

He was named a life trustee upon retirement as an active

member of the board in 1969.

Funeral services for Kirkpatrick were held at the First United Methodist Church in Omaha on Wednesday. Grinnell College officials were in attendance.
