Jesse Knudson, 89, of 3074 Highway 146, rural Gilman, died Monday, July 13, at Grinnell Regional Medical Center.

Funeral services were conducted Thursday at the Estel-Perrin-Avey Chapel in Marshalltown, with the Rev. Neil Montz of the Laurel United Methodist Church officiating. Burial was in Rose Hill Memorial Gardens, Marshalltown.

He was the son of Andrew and Anna Tjossem Knudson and was born Jan. 2, 1909, on the family farm near Marshalltown. He received his education in rural schools and graduated from Marshalltown High School in 1925. Following his graduation, he and his brother, John, farmed on the family farm.
