Olga M. "Jenz" Korfmacher, 89, of Grinnell died of cancer Wednesday, Nov. 8, at St. Francis Manor.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday at the United Church of Christ - Congregational, with the Rev. Robert Molsberry officiating. Burial will be in Hazelwood Cemetery, with the Smith Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.

The daughter of Anton and Hansigne Jensen, she was born Jan. 6, 1906, in Cedar Falls. She was a graduate of Cedar Falls High School and later received her R.N. degree from Iowa Lutheran Hospital School of Nursing.

She was married to Edwin Korfmacher in 1929, and the couple lived in Grinnell. She trained nurses' aides during World War II and was active in a number of social and service organizations. She was past president of the Iowa State PEO and a member of the Levart Club, Priscilla Club and United Church of Christ - Congregational. Following the death of her husband in 1960, she returned to work as a nurse at Grinnell General Hospital where she served as a supervisor.
