Floyd J. Kriedel, 83, Olympia, Wash., died of natural causes Thursday, March 23, 1989, in the Evergreen Convalescent Center, Olympia. He had been a resident of Olympia the past 34 years and had also lived in Brooklyn, Iowa, and Tacoma, Wash.
