Joseph Patrick Kriegel, 78, of Chariton, formerly of Tama, died Thursday, Nov. 23, at the Veterans Administration Hospital in Knoxville.

Funeral services were conducted Monday at the chapel of Mason-Hand Funeral Home in Tama, with the Revs. Peter J. Peterson and Pat Vick officiating. Burial was in Sheridan Cemetery, Poweshiek County.

The son of Joseph and Sadie Clark Kriegel, he was born Nov. 16, 1911, in Poweshiek County. He received his education in rural school.
