Grace Krumm, 91, of Grinnell died of congestive heart failure Sunday, Dec. 16, at Friendship Manor.

Funeral services were held Wednesday at the First Baptist Church, with the Rev. Tim Stewart officiating. Music was provided by Denise Baustian, organist, and Rhonda Minner, vocalist.
