dies, rites set

The Rev. Fr. Leo V. Kuebrich. 73, pastor emeritus of St. Mary's Catholic Church, died at his apartment at 1121 West St. early Tuesday morning of an apparent heart attack.

His death came on the same date, <u>June 26</u>, when he arrived in Grinnell 21 years earlier, in 1958

The Mass of the Resurrection for Fr. Kuebrich will be celebrated at 11 a.m. Friday at St. Mary's, with the Most Rev. Gerald F. O'Keefe, bishop of Davenport, as the principal celebrant and homilist. Concelebrants will be the Rev. Harry H. Linnenbrink, the Rev. Robert Amborn, the Rev. David Goetsch. the Rev. Albert Goetzman, the Rev. Edmund Weeg, the Rev. Louis Rohret, and Msgr. Cletus Madsen. Organist will be John W. Penne.

Obituary

The son of Jacob W. and Jane Bradley Kuebrich, he was born at Cosgrove on April 2, 1906. He attended Cosgrove schools. St. Ambrose Academy and St. Ambrose College at Davenport, and Kenrick Seminary at St. Louis, Mo.

Fr. Kuebrich was ordained on May 21, 1932, at Davenport. During his career he served as associate pastor at St. Mary's Church in Muscatine and St. Mary's Church in Ft. Madison. He was pastor of Sacred Heart Church, Kinross: St. Joseph Church, Wellman; and St. Mary's Church, Grinnell.

He also served as chaplain of Sanguis de Christo Council of the Knights of Columbus in Grinnell. He was appointed dean of the Grinnell Deanery on April 24, 1972, and retired from active parish work on Oct. 29, 1976.

Fr. Kuebrich is survived by a brother, William P. Kuebrich of Cosgrove, and four sisters, Stella and Marguerite Kuebrich of Iowa City, Mrs. Orville (Mary) Wagner of Iowa City, and Mrs. Genevieve Krell of Iowa City.

His cousin is the Rt. Rev. Msgr. J.J. Welsh of Davenport.
