Carl O. Kvinlaug, 81, of Gilman died Saturday, Aug. 31, at Branson, Mo.

Funeral services were conducted Wednesday at Pursel-Davis Funeral Home in Marshalltown, with the Rev. Larry Hoffman of Grace Believers Church in Toledo officiating. Burial was in Prairieview Cemetery, Gilman.

The son of Jacob and Minnie Olsson Kvinlaug, he was born in Marshall County June 15, 1915. He was raised and educated in the LeGrand and Gilman areas and was a 1935 graduate of Gilman High School.

He was married to Luella Mae Slingluff May 25, 1940, in Marshalltown. Mr. Kvinlaug farmed in the Gilman and LeGrand areas until 1960. He later worked for the Gilman Farmers Cooperative for several years. He retired from the cooperative in the mid-1970s and opened Carl's Cleaning Center. He operated the cleaning center until his retirement in 1985.

He was a member of the Gilman Community Church, and he had served as a volunteer firefighter and on the Gilman City Council.

Surviving are three daughters, Linda Ryan of Des Moines, Carleen Hinegardner of Montour and Debbie Kvinlaug of St. Louis, Mo.; one brother, Robert Kvinlaug of Gilman; a sister, Olive Showalter of Gilman; four grandchildren; and four great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife; one brother, Jerry; and one sister, Hazel Raymond.
