Hold rites for William Lacy

William F. Lacy, 72, of 508 Park St. in Grinnell, died Sunday afternoon at Grinnell General Hospital. 4-17-77

Funeral services for William Lacy were held at 10 a.m. on Wednesday, April 20, at the Smith Funeral Home. The Rev. Eugene McClure officiated. Music was by Mrs. Kathleen Heffner. Pallbearers were Ferry Fair, William Hagen, Frank LaGrange, James Miller, O.R. Peterson, and Bill Verneburg.
