Harrison Lamb, Former Resident Dies In Waterloo

Harrison T. Lamb, 73, former Grinnell resident, died Oct. 3rd at a Waterloo hospital.

Funeral services were held this afternoon (Thursday) from the Bramer Funeral Home at Brooklyn. Pallbearers, all ne-
