

## Mr. Landuyt Services Held <sup>6/14</sup>

Rene Landuyt, 72, of <sup>715</sup> Center St., Brooklyn, died Thursday morning at Grinnell General Hospital.

He was born Jan. 8, 1901, in Domkerke, Buijsselede, Belgium. He came to the United States in 1920, living first in Independence, Iowa. He later moved to Detroit, Mich., then to Canada, returning later to Detroit.

Mr. Landuyt was married to Hortense Desmet Oct. 15, 1923, in Detroit. They moved to Iowa in 1931. A retired farmer, Mr. Landuyt was a member of St. Patrick's Catholic Church, Brooklyn.

Survivors include his wife Hortense; one son, Aime of Marengo; five grandchildren; and two great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents, an infant son, and one grandson.

Funeral services for Mr. Landuyt were held at 10 a.m. Saturday in St. Patrick's Catholic Church, with the Rev. Patrick McCoy officiating. A rosary was held at 8 p.m. Friday at the Nevenhoven Funeral Home.

Burial was in Calvary Cemetery, Brooklyn.
