Mrs. Ellen Lang, 81, the widow of Allen A. Lang, died Monday morning (July 2) at Friendship Manor Nursing Home in Grinnell. Mrs. Lang had been a resident of Madison Township until the past six months when she moved to Grinnell to be near her daughter.

The daughter of Jens and Serina Stangeland Hendrickson, she was born Feb. 12, 1892, near Brooklyn. She attended the rural schools near her home. On March 6, 1912, she was married to Allen A. Lang at Brooklyn. The couple had two children, Mrs. Elwood (Pauline) Burlingame of Grinnell and Wallace Lang of Hampton.

Mrs. Lang was a member of the Madison Church of Christ.
