John G. Langmaid was born in Oak Ridge neighborhood west of Newton on August 8, 1877, and died at the University hospital in Iowa City on July 19th. A stroke following surgery was attributed as the cause of death.

The son of Albert and Mary Langmaid, he lived most of his life in Criannell and Marshall town where he was a painter and paper hanger. In 1910, he was married to Edith Helyer, who died in 1923.

He is survived by two sisters, Mrs. John Mackerman of Newton and Mrs. Clark Whitlock of Fort Worth, Texas; and a foster daughter, Mrs. Swede Nelson of Burbank, Calif. Also surviving are 13 nieces and nephews.
