Lloyd E. Large, 72, of Kellogg died Wednesday, Oct. 20, at Williamsburg Community Hospital, Williamsburg, Va.

Graveside services were conducted Saturday at Rock Creek Cemetery near Grinnell, with the Rev. David Green, pastor of the Grinnell Assembly of God Church, officiating.

The son of Cyrus and Maggie Emperly Large, he was born Dec. 4, 1920, in Exline. He attended school there.

During World War II he served with the U.S. Marine Corps in the Pacific theater. Following the war he was married to Jerry Diesch in Burlington.
