Henry Larson, 86, Funeral Rites At Decorah Friday

Henry O. Larson, 86, died Monday at a local hospital after an illness of 10 days.

Mr. Larson had been making his home in Grinnell with his daughter, Mrs. G. M. Thomann, since last November.
