Rites held for Mary Latcham

Mary Margaret Latcham, 90, of 1322 Spring St., Grinnell, died early Tuesday at Grinnell General Hospital. *Oct. 17*

Funeral services were held at 10 a.m. today at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Daniel Ogata, pastor of the First United Presbyterian Church, officiating. Organist was Mrs. Willard Heffner, and pallbearers were Dan Agnew, Robert Agnew, William R. Cleland, Allen L. Latcham, Leonard Latcham and Donald R. Souter.

Burial was at Pleasant Township Cemetery at Ewart.

The daughter of David and Sarah Patterson Agnew, she was born Feb. 4, 1885, in Campbellford, Ontario, Canada. She attended public schools in Sault Ste. Marie, Mich., and rural school near her family's farm near Ewart.

On March 7, 1917, she was married to Harry Clifton Latcham in Daveuport. Following their marriage, Mr. and Mrs. Latcham made their home in Ewart and later moved to Grinnell. Mrs. Latcham was a member of the First United Presbyterian Church and had worked in the housekeeping department at Grinnell College and the former Community Hospital.
