### Mr. Lavery

Thomas L. Lavery, 66, of rural  
Laurel died Friday at  
University Hospitals in Iowa  
City, where he had been a  
patient since Tuesday.

Funeral services were held  
at 10:30 a.m. Monday at the

of Marshalltown in charge of
