## Last Rites Said For Alma Lee

Funeral services were held at 1 p.m., Saturday, Dec. 1, for Mrs. Alma Lee, 78, of Malcom, who died Thursday morning at Grinnell General Hospital East where she had been hospitalized for ten days.

Services were held at the James-Schalinske Funeral Home with the Rev. Ronald Spears, pastor of St. John's Lutheran church, officiating. Organist was Mrs. Willard Heffner and vocalist was Margaret Taylor.

Pallbearers were Raymond Larsen, Ernest Larsen, Donald Larsen, Donald Hull, Floyd White, and Donald Morrison. Burial was in Hazelwood cemetery.

The daughter of Anne and Bertha Bergeson Johnson, Mrs. Lee was born Jan. 10, 1890, in Malcom Township. She received her education in the rural schools at Malcom and was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith.

On Feb. 6, 1929, she was united in marriage with Knud Lee at her parents' home in Grinnell. Following their marriage they farmed on her home place southeast of Grinnell. In 1951 when they retired, they moved to Malcom. Mrs. Lee was a member of the Harmony Ladies Aid at Malcom.

Survivors include her husband Knud; two daughters — Mrs. Bruce (Irene) Mecartea of Fresno, Calif., and Mrs. Harold (Ann) Beck of Omaha, Neb.; and four grandchildren — Marcia, Patricia, Nancy and Wayne Beck of Omaha.

Mrs. Lee was preceded in death by her parents, one sister—Bessie Johnson, and a grandson, Larry Beck.
