
Roy Andrew Leeper



Roy Andrew Leeper, 82, of Grinnell died Thursday, Aug. 3, at Friendship Manor.

He was a veteran of the U.S. Navy during World War II and served in the Marshall Islands after graduating third in his class from the Navy Electronic School in St. Louis.

He was married to Rena Vose Nov. 3, 1935, in Waterloo. He was employed with the Chamberlain Corporation and Davis Radio in Waterloo. They moved to Grinnell in 1947 where he owned and operated with his wife the Leeper Music Co. The couple moved to the Rock Creek Lake area in 1967 and retired in 1978.

Mr. Leeper was a member of the Seventh-day Adventist Church, serving as an elder and deacon, and was a 50-year member of the American Legion. He was a former member of the Kiwanis Club.

Surviving are his wife; one son, James of Roseville, Calif.; three grandchildren; two great-grandchildren; and one sister, Gladys Leeper of Lancaster, Calif.

He was preceded in death by his parents; one sister, Hilda Norris; and two brothers, Denzel and Harry.
