Rites Wednesday For Mrs. Ella Legg, 89

Funeral services for Mrs. Ella Legg, 89, of Brooklyn, were held Wednesday at the Avon church. Burial was in Shriver cemetery near Seymour.

Mrs. Legg, who lived with her son, Welburne Legg in Brooklyn died Monday, Oct. 16, at the home of a daughter in Des Moines. She had been in ill health since suffering a fall several months ago.

Ella Legg, daughter of Rose and Henry Leary was born in Illinois Aug. 8, 1878. At an early age she joined the Methodist church at Harvard, Iowa, later changing her membership to the Avon Community church. She spent most of her life in the Harvard and Seymour area before moving to Des Moines and later to Brooklyn.

She was united in marriage to Charles Anthony Legg. They were the parents of six children. She also raised two step-daughters from infancy.
