Louis F. Lenz, 88, of 218 East St., Kellogg, died of congestive heart failure Sunday, Jan. 22, at Friendship Manor in Grinnell.

Funeral services were conducted Wednesday at the Kellogg United Methodist church, with the Rev. William Long officiating. Burial was in Our Silent City Cemetery, Kellogg, with the Wallace-Pence Funeral Home of Newton in charge of arrangements.
