Edwin Lewis, a former resident of Montezuma and a brother of Judge W. R. Lewis, died Friday of last week in Alabama, where he had resided for the past nine years. Mr. Lewis came to Montezuma in 1875 and engaged in abstracting finally becoming owner of the set of books now operated by the Hawkeye Abstract Company. He sold his interests in the county seat in January 1913 and moved to Lillian, Alabama, on the north coast of the Gulf of Mexico and a few miles across the bay from Pensacola where he engaged in fruit growing.
