Services Conducted For Frank Lincoln

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. today (Monday, Feb. 3) at the Smith Funeral Home for Francis Henry (Frank) Lincoln, 76, of Grinnell, who died suddenly Friday evening at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Smith Davis, 1111 Washington Ave., where he had lived for several years.

The Rev. Leslie O. Warner, pastor of the First Friends Church, officiated at the services. Mrs. Frank Mitchell was organist and Donald Strand, Jerry Reed, Dennis Reed, Jim Klemm, Larry Reed and Gordon Hendrickson were pallbearers.

Burial was in Hazelwood Cemetery.

The son of Ernest and Elizabeth Thompson Lincoln, Mr. Lincoln was born Dec. 5, 1892, on a farm in the Oak Grove community. He was married to Nora Martin.

Mr. Lincoln farmed south of Grinnell for many years and later was employed with the street department of the City of Grinnell. He had moved into Grinnell about 35 years ago. He was a member of the Oak Grove Friends Church.
