Nellie M. Lincoln, 89, of 1900 Fourth ave., Grinnell, died Monday, Nov. 7, at Grinnell General Hospital.

Funeral services were conducted at 1:30 p.m. Wednesday at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Howard Lord officiating. Organist was Laura Oliver, and soloist was Greg Lincoln. Pallbearers were Harold Brown, Robert Dale, Charles De Pauw, Robert Osborn, Martin Pierce and Donald Rempp.

She served as treasurer of the Westfield church and was also a long-time member of the Westfield Grange. She served as secretary of the Westfield Ladies' Aid and as treasurer of the Grinnell chapter of the Women's Christian Temperance Union (WCTU).

She is survived by a sister, Hazel Lincoln. She was preceded in death by her parents; two brothers, Robert and James Lincoln; and a sister, Addie Jones.
