Ruth Lind Dies In California

Ruth Knight Lind (Mrs. Leonard G. Lind), a former resident of Grinnell, passed away Wednesday, July 19, in an Oakland, Calif., hospital, following a brief illness.

Mrs. Lind, the daughter of the late Frank and Alice Blaisdelle Knight, long-time residents of Grinnell, was born here on November 22, 1903. Following graduation from Grinnell High School and Grinnell College, she taught in the Toledo, Cedar Falls and Minneapolis schools. Upon completion of graduate work at Northwestern University, she was married on April 23, 1939, to Leonard G. Lind of Council Bluffs.

In 1955 the family moved to Livermore, Calif., where Mr. Lind was associated with the Radiation Laboratory of the University of California. After Mr. Lind's death in 1962, Mrs. Lind taught in several schools in the northern California area. She spent several months in Grinnell this past winter with her sister, Mrs. Fred Ramsey.

In addition to her husband, Mrs. Lind was preceded in death by her daughter, Carole Lind O'Leary in July, 1966.

Survivors include her son, Jon Lind of Seattle, Wash., and her sisters, Mrs. John Saris of Evanston, Ill., and Mrs. Fred Ramsey of Grinnell.

Services for Mrs. Lind were held in the First Presbyterian church of Livermore, with her close friend and pastor, the Rev. John Turpin, conducting the services. Burial was in Rose Lawn cemetery, Livermore.
