

John Linden, Here 35 Years, Dies Thursday

John Linden, Grinnell resident 35 years, died at a local hospital early this morning, Thursday, Feb. 24, following a long illness. He was 75 years old.

Funeral services will be held from St. Mary's Catholic church at 10:15 Saturday morning with Father V. A. Walsh officiating. Rosary will be recited at 8:30 Friday evening.

A carpenter, Mr. Linden came to Grinnell from Kansas via other Iowa communities. He had been in ill health for several years.

Son of Mathias and Elizabeth Bencken Linden, both deceased, he was born at Waukeegan, Ill., Oct. 23, 1879. He was married to Anna Kauken of New Almeno, Kansas, on Nov. 18, 1902. They observed their golden wedding anniversary in 1952.

Mr. Linden was a member of the St. Mary's Catholic Church and Holy Name Society.

Surviving are his wife, Anna of Grinnell; a daughter, Mrs. Joe (Vera) Hotchkin of Grinnell; one granddaughter; and a niece, Mrs. Walter Kalaupok of Grand Forks, N. D., who was reared by the Lindens.

Also surviving are three sisters, Mrs. Hattie Long of Camas Village, Ore.; Mrs. Carl Steimel of Arcata, Calif.; and Mrs. Rose Nelson of Portland, Ore.; three brothers, Joe and Frank Linden of Clayton, Kan., and Henry of Denver, Colo.; and several nieces and nephews.
