

Andrew Lineweaver

Andrew David Lineweaver, third son of Charles and Rebecca Lineweaver, was born on a farm, south of Brooklyn, August 21, 1886 and died at the Iowa Methodist hospital, Des Moines, Dec. 28, 1966 at the age of eighty years, four months and seven days. He had been ill seven weeks. He was a graduate of Brooklyn high school, class of 1904, and spent his early life around Brooklyn.

On Jan. 29, 1908 he married Nellie Viola Evans. To this union were born four daughters. The oldest daughter, Lois Harfield, one grandson, Larry Parr, four sisters and three brothers, preceded him in
