Sylvester Linstead, who lived in the very southwest of Poweshiek, died Tuesday, July 12, at the home where he had lived for 64 years.

Alonzo Sylvester Linsted was born in Gardner, Maine, on February 14, 1850, a son of Alfred P. and Mary Comstock Linsted, the father a native of Boston and the mother of Great Barrington, Massachusetts.

When oily 7 years of age he came with his parents to Iowa and located on a farm in Sugar Creek Township, has father having purchased the farm from the government the previous year.
