

Little rites held here

Clifford E. Little, 62, died Monday morning, June 21, in his 303 Broad St. home of an apparent heart condition.

Funeral services for Clifford Little were held at 1 p.m. on Wednesday, June 23, at the Smith Funeral Home. The Rev. Winford Clifton, minister of the First Friends Church officiated and music was provided by Mrs. Kathleen Heffner. Pallbearers were Van Davis, Jr., Francis Graves, Ron Kerber, James H.
