## Tuesday Services Scheduled For Martha Littrell

Mrs. Martha Littrell, 85, Grinnell, widow of Jonah Littrell, died at a local hospital Saturday evening following a month's hospitalization.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Tuesday from the Smith Funeral Home with the Rev. C. E. Kingsley, pastor of the First Baptist church, officiating. Organ music will be by Mrs. Esther Auman.

Pallbearers will be Fred Weber, Beckham Sutton, Claude Thompson, Albert Deppe, Raymond Norris and Francis Schmitz. Burial will be in Hazelwood cemetery.

She was the daughter of William and Emily Aires Caldwell and was born April 3rd, 1875 at Crab Orchard, Ky. She received her early education there and on March 25th, 1894, at Stanford, Ky., she was united in marriage with Jonah Littrell.

To this union were born five children: Cicero Littrell, deceased; Mrs. Will (Wadie) Deppe of Kellogg; Nola, who died at age 4; Mrs. Harry (Viola) Hartzell, Grinnell; and another daughter who died in infancy.

In addition to her two daughters, she is survived by three grandchildren and six great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her husband on Feb. 10th, 1960, three children, four brothers, and three sisters.

Mrs. Littrell came to Grinnell from Eubanks, Ky., over 53 years ago. She was a member of the First Baptist church.
