Telford B. Lodden, 86, died February 25, 1998 at the Montezuma Nursing and Rehabilitation Center.

Funeral services were Monday, March 2 at Ankeny Funeral Home. Interment was at Lincoln Cemetery in Alleman, Iowa.

Telford was born to Christ and Inger (Hokel) Lodden February 11, 1912 in the Huxley-Cambridge Area. He lived in central Iowa all of his life.
