## Helen Loehwing

Helen Loehwing, 96, of the Mayflower died Wednesday, Oct. 13, at the Mayflower Health Care Center.

A memorial service will be held at 10 a.m. Friday in Denison Chapel of the Mayflower. There will be no visitation. Memorial contributions in her name may be made to the Mayflower Human Needs Fund.

She was the daughter of Emory and Lela Lundy Cromer and was born March 31, 1897, in Butte, Mont. She was a graduate of Cornell College in Mount Vernon and received her master's degree in botany from the University of Iowa. She taught biology at Aberdeen, S.D.
