Funeral services for Richard Lee Long, 15-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Roger Long of Torrance, Calif., who died Oct. 27 from injuries received in a water skiing accident, will be held at 10 a.m. Friday at the Smith Funeral Home in Grinnell.

The Rev. J. Lester Williams, pastor of the Calvary Baptist Church in Manning, Iowa, will officiate. Organist will be Kathy Otto and casket bearers will be Kenneth Massengale, Jerry Massengale, Larry Massengale, David Massengale, Jim Massengale and Carl Massengale.

Burial will be in Rock Creek Cemetery west of Grinnell.

Richard was born March 27, 1953, in Grinnell. He attended Davis elementary school in Grinnell and attended West High School in Torrance when his family moved. He was a member of the sophomore class. He had been with a group camping out for the weekend when the skiing accident occurred on the Colorado River near Parker, Ariz.

Survivors include his parents; one brother, Steve, 17 years old; one sister, Cathy, 13 years old; his maternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Marvin Cooper of Rt. 2, Kellogg; his paternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Harold Long of Hiawatha, Iowa; and several other relatives.
