Charles O. Lord was born at Shapley, York Co., Maine, February 6th,

1849, and died at his home near Westneld on Friday Dec. 30, 1904 at the age of 55 years 10 months and 24 days.

In the east he spent the earlier years of his life, until he enlisted in the army March '64. He remained in active service and in the hospital until the close of the war.

He was converted when nineteen years of age and united with the M. E. Church. Of this church he has ever since been a member, and by his sincere and active christian life has been a witness of the reality of Christianity.

After a few years he came to Chester. Since '71 his life has mostly been spent near Grinnell.

Mr. Lord has always been an active church worker and has for years been superintendent of the Westfield Sunday School. He will be greatly missed by the church and by the community.

Short funeral services were conducted from the house at 12 o'clock Sunday by Rev. Robert Lincoln and at 1:30 from the Westfield Church by the Rev. J. M. McCielland. The services at the grave were in charge of Gordon Post. No. 64. The interment was in the the Westfield Cemetery.
