

## Miriam Loudon <sup>10/19</sup> (Donald) Rites Tuesday <sup>71</sup>

Miriam Loudon, 54, the wife of Donald Loudon, of 1429 Broad St., died Sunday afternoon, Oct. 18, at Grinnell General Hospital, following an extended illness.

The daughter of James A. and Florence Glen McCulley Brecken, she was born June 30, 1917, at Newburg. She received her education at the Newburg schools and was a graduate of the University of Northern Iowa. She taught schools in Alexander, Baxter and South Tama.
