William Luckey, for fifteen years a resident of Grinnell, died at his home on North West street Saturday morning. He was 57 years old. Funeral services were held from the home Sunday at 3 p. m. "Rev. G. P. Mitchell was in charge of the ceremonies.

Mr. Luckey's death was caused by a third stroke of paralysis. He had been ill for a long time. During the years of his active life here he was an employe of the Spaulding Manufacturing Company.
