Nettie Lukehart Dies Suddenly Wednesday Nite

Mrs. Nettie Lukehart, 67, of Grinnell, died suddenly at her home at 1607 Main St. Wednesday evening.

She was born June 4, 1896, in Iowa county, Wis., the daughter of Evan and Belle Rundall Griffiths. Following her education in the schools of Wisconsin, she moved to Laurel, Iowa, where she lived most of her life.

Mrs. Lukehart moved to Grinnell about four years ago to be near her daughter.

On Oct. 2, 1913, at Marshalltown, she was united in marriage with Clarence W. Lukehart, and to this union two children were born—William Lavern Lukehart of Cedar Rapids and Mrs. Raymond Delores Bellinger Koger of Grinnell.

She is also survived by her four grandchildren, Allen and Janet Lukehart and Steven and Cindy Koger.

Preceding her in death were her parents; her husband Clarence in 1956; and one brother, Dewey Griffiths.

She attended the Laurel Methodist church and was a member of the W.S.C.S.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Saturday from the Laurel Methodist church with the pastor, the Rev. Darwin Pierce, officiating. Burial will be in Graceland cemetery, Laurel.
