

Former Resident Dies in Arizona

Funeral services were held April 11 at Green Ridge Baptist church, Eldon, Mo., for Clyde William Lunceford of Glendale, Ariz., former resident of the Brooklyn area.

Mr. Lunceford died April 6 at Phoenix, Ariz., victim of a heart attack, two weeks before his 65th birthday.
