**Former resident
LYNCH, Delmer
dies in Missouri**

Funeral services were held on Monday, Aug. 9, for a former Sheridan resident, Delmer E. Lynch, 57.

Lynch, who had been living in Belton, Mo., died on Saturday, Aug. 7, at his home.

He was born on Dec. 8, 1918 in Malcom, the son of Ernest and Francis (Cogley) Lynch, and farmed in the Sheridan area until 1952, when he and his family moved to Belton.

He was married to Pauline Combs of Brooklyn on Dec. 15, 1940.
