Alvin Wilford Mann, 75, died May 31 at Grinnell General Hospital.

The son of Hambra and Elsie Jones Mann, he was born Feb. 1, 1899, in Pleasant Township. He attended schools in the Malcom and Montezuma areas. In 1912, his parents moved to the farm on which he had lived since. He was graduated in 1923 from a two-year agricultural course at Iowa State College.

On June 2, 1926, he was married to Addie Mary Sanders. The couple had two children.

Mr. Mann was an active member of the United Presbyterian Church; the Lilly Lodge No. 254, the A.F. and A.M.; and Holly Chapter No. 147 of the Order of Eastern Star.
