## Kenneth Marchant Succumbs Here; Rites At Bagley 965

Kenneth Lament Marchant, 54, of Grinnell, died at a local hospital on Tuesday, Dec. 13th.

Funeral services were held Dec. 16th at the Christian church at Bagley, Iowa. Interment was at Dodge cemetery at Bagley.

The son of Jobe and Araminta Marchant, he was born at Fausler, Iowa, in Guthrie county, on Dec. 15th, 1910. He was united in marriage with Dorothy Clark of Bagley, Iowa, on Jan. 23rd, 1930.

Three daughters were born to the union, Mrs. Ramona Myers and Mrs. Charlene Baderstadt of Des Moines, and Miss Phyllis Marchant at home in Grinnell.

In May of 1952, he and his family moved to Grinnell where they have since resided.

He enlisted in the Navy in May of 1945 and served in the Pacific on the island of Iwo Jima until the end of the war. He was discharged on October, 1945.

Survivors include his wife, Dorothy; three daughters; five grandsons and one granddaughter; and numerous other relatives.
