

Sanitarian Markham dies; rites Saturday

Poweshiek County Sanitarian Terry L. Markham, 26, of 1124 Reed St., Grinnell, collapsed in the ASCS office in Malcom shortly before noon Wednesday. He was dead on arrival at Grinnell General Hospital.

An autopsy was set for 8 a.m. today to determine the cause of death.

Funeral services will be held Saturday morning at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Lamont, Iowa, with burial at St. Albert's Cemetery near that community. The Kreussel-Fawcett Funeral Home is in charge of arrangements.

The son of Grover R. and Betty Opperman Markham, he

was born June 10, 1948, in Manchester, Iowa. He attended the Lamont public schools and was graduated from Starmont Community High School in 1966. He attended Northern Iowa Community College in Mason City for two years and was graduated from Upper Iowa College in Fayette.

On May 5, 1973, he was married to Janet Anne Goedken in Lamont. They moved to Grinnell in April of 1974, when Mr. Markham assumed duties as sanitarian for the county. He was a member of the Grinnell Lions Club.

Survivors include his wife, Janet; his parents; two brothers, Lynn Markham of Hiawatha and Kevin Markham of Lamont; and his maternal grandfather, Ed Opperman of Cedar Rapids.
