Kellogg Services Held Today For Robert Marr, 48

A lifetime Kellogg resident, Robert B. Marr, 48, died Thursday evening at his home.

Funeral services were conducted this afternoon (Monday) from the Christian church of Kellogg with the Rev. Charles Fry, pastor, officiating. Interment was in Our Silent City cemetery at Kellogg.

Born August 2, 1914, at Kellogg, he was the son of Marion F. and Amanda Sloan Marr. He was educated in the Kellogg schools and spent his entire life in that community.

Mr. Marr was a painter and had been employed by the Iowa Water Tower Paint and Repair Co. of Clear Lake for the past 16 years.

Survivors include his mother, Mrs. Glen Stewart of Kellogg; two sisters, Mrs. Richard (Nell) Heck of Des Moines, and Mrs. Jean Spooner of Waterloo; four brothers, Walter and Cyrus of Kellogg, and Roy and Glen of Waterloo.

He was preceded in death by a brother in 1916 and his father in 1917.
